Club Car Championship at The Landings Golf & Athletic Club to award 2026 tournament exemptions to Augusta native Hamilton Coleman and University of Georgia alum Buck Brumlow

Tournament introduces 2026 Kid Correspondent in partnership with 100 Black Men of Savannah

SAVANNAH, GA – Tournament officials announced today that Hamilton Coleman and Buck Brumlow will receive exemptions to compete in the ninth playing of the Club Car Championship at The Landings Golf & Athletic Club.

The 2026 edition of Savannah’s official Korn Ferry Tour event is March 23–29 at The Landings Golf & Athletic Club’s acclaimed Deer Creek Course.

“We are excited to welcome Hamilton and Buck into the field for this year’s Club Car Championship at The Landings Golf & Athletic Club,” said Brit Donahue, tournament director. “Uplifting the Georgia community is an important mission of the tournament, and we are thrilled for these up-and-coming golfers to be making their Korn Ferry Tour debuts in their home state.”

Coleman, 17, is an Augusta, Georgia native committed to the University of Georgia men’s golf program and has quickly emerged as one of the top junior golfers in the country. In 2025, Coleman captured the U.S. Junior Amateur Championship, earning exemptions into the 2026 U.S. Open and U.S. Amateur, and previously won the 2024 Junior PLAYERS Championship.

Brumlow, 23, played collegiately at the University of Georgia where he earned All-SEC and Southeast All-Region honors. The Atlanta native captured his first collegiate title at the 2025 Invitational at The Ford, earning him an exemption into the Club Car Championship. Brumlow turned professional in July of last year and recorded two top 25 finishes over 10 PGA TOUR Americas starts during his rookie campaign.

The exemption process that will award one spot in the tournament field of competitors to the winner of

The Invitational at The Ford will continue for 2027. Hosted annually at The Ford Field & River Club – Ford Plantation Course in Richmond Hill, Georgia, The Invitational at The Ford is a two-day, 54-hole men’s collegiate event that will feature eight invited teams. The second annual tournament will be played April 13-14, 2026.

The Club Car Championship also announced today the return of the tournament’s Kid Correspondent Program, in partnership with the 100 Black Men of Savannah. The 2026 official correspondent of the Championship, Baraka, will experience a full day of activities, including the Opening Ceremony, access to post-round Korn Ferry Tour player interviews, a shadowing experience with tournament officials and more.
